## **Notes:**

1. This guide is designed for a student who begins at MMCC with a focus on SVSU's RN-to-BSN program. Individualized advising is strongly recommended. Meet with SVSU transfer advisor early in program at MMCC.
2. Program requirements may change at any time; thus students are encouraged to check frequently with advisors at both institutions.
3. This guide is based on fulfilling SVSU's 10-Category General Education requirements not MTA for the purpose of saving credits and cost in transfer. Please note that HUM 200 and SSC 200 will fulfill the SVSU requirement for two Communication Intensive (CI) courses selected from Categories 2-8.
4. Please be aware that all SVSU BSN nursing courses will be offered in a hybrid format (some face to face and some online course work). This format allows for greater flexibility and decreases commute and campus time.
5. Please be aware that SVSU will transfer in a maximum of 62 Community College credits (NUR courses are treated separately for an additional 32 articulation credits after successful completion of SVSU's NURS 301/Nursing Care Designer 1 for RNs). Total transfer & articulation credits shall not exceed 93 credits. Students must meet a 31 credit hour residency requirement at SVSU and have 42 credits at the 300-400 level in order to earn the SVSU bachelor degree.
6. If you are planning to go straight into SVSU's MSN program, some of these courses may not be required. Please check with the RN-BSN Coordinator at SVSU prior to taking these classes.
